September 9, 2022 – Montreal Kosher of Canada’s First Update

MK of Canada posted this to their email list:

“Dear Consumers,

We are pleased to share with you the latest Yoshon update.

Any flour with a COR323 carrying a ‘SK’ plant code and a date code of 2-230 or lower is Yoshon. 2-231 and above are from the new crop and can not be considered Yoshon. Costco in Montreal very often carries this flour. If the plant code is ‘MT’ - it is still yoshon.

For durum semolina and Atta flour a date code of 2-234 or lower is Yoshon.

Stock up on Oats and barley.
