Products Update

Clarification on Made Good products Yeshon codes:

USA: All production for Made Good takes place in Canada including their products shipped and sold in the US. The laws and regulations on how to label the production date (lot #) differs from place to place. The Codes provided on the earlier Yeshon list is the Julien date method. This is the method of dating the Made Good products sold in the states.

Julien date: 2442 or lower (day 244 of year 2022).

Canada: Made Good products sold in Canada are labeled as follows MMY. For example, 0922 corresponds to September 2022. One can deduce the day of the month of production by the Best Before date. For example, for a BB date of January 24 2024 and lot # 0922, one can deduce that production date was September 24 2022.

We are trying to obtain a more accurate cutoff date.

For the time being:

lot # 0822 or lower is Yeshon. Lot # 0922 remains sofek Chodosh. Lot #1022 or above should already be treated as Chodosh.

Compliments Flour

Compliments flour bearing a OU symbol sold at IGA carries the same Yeshon codes as Robin Hood, Five Roses and Selection flour.

1 The Date code corresponds to the Julien date. For example, day 2 -230 is the 230th day of year 2022 which corresponds to august 18 2022. These numbers or lower are Yeshon.
 2 The Plant code refers to the plant that the product was manufactured. First, locate the plant code on the full code that is printed on the bag, then read the year and date codes.

Establishment Update

PIZZA PITA PRIME - **Food:** Pizza, Falafel, borekas, oven baked veggie burgers and garlic knots are Yeshon. **Bread:** Pita and wraps only Yeshon. **Not Yeshon:** All fries, poutine gravy, pizza wrap and parve shawarma, sushi and pasta are **not** certified Yeshon.

MIMIMELON –Bread, pastry and fried fish only are Yeshon. Bridor Baguette and Baguette crackers are not Yeshon.
