3. Sage purchase dates for Yoshon products:

Durum Wheat: Aug 1.

The actual cut off dates are likely to be at least a few days later.

TYNI Note: It should be noted that they mention the *purchase dates*, which are not the same as the general grain cutoffs, with which all product's dates are estimated from. Purchase dates can vary with certain conditions, such as shipping areas, individual store sale prices and stock rotation.
