

Yoshon Beers List - Updated February 21, 2024

Beers are usually *yoshon* only with specific criteria such as *hashgacha*, specific sizes, or dates. This list changes from year to year, and is updated as necessary. Breweries are listed in bold type.

<u>Made in the USA:</u> Items with cutoff dates are *yoshon* only before the following dates or lot codes. They may or may not have *hashgacha*.

Budweiser Beer: Date Code: Freshest Before MAR 04 2024 (110 days). **Coors Beer**: Date Code: Best By 3 15 24 (3=March, 15=day, 24=year) (1 yr).

Heineken Beer: Packing Date: 3319 (3=2023, 319=November 15).

Mickeys Fine Malt Liquor: Packing Date: (1st Line Only) MAY DD 24 45 (MAY DD=Unimportant,

24=Year+1, 45=Week).

Miller Beer: Date Code: Best By Date 03 15 4 (03=March, 15=day, 4=2024) (4 mo).

Pabst Beer: Date Code: Best By 4 135 (4=2024, 135=May 15) (6 mo).

Samuel Adams Barley Beers: (w/ Star-K only) Date Code: Best Before MAY 2024 (6 mo). **Samuel Adams Wheat Beers:** (w/ Star-K only) Date Code: Best Before MAY 2024 (6 mo).

<u>Beer Made in Israel:</u> All must be under OK hashgacha with a hechsher, with the following criteria: **Israel Beer Breweries:** Yoshon only with "ללא חשש חדש", an OK symbol, and the company address "בר לב אשקלון" in these sizes:

Carlsberg – 0.0% Beer (yoshon without any size restrictions).

Carlsberg Beer – in .5L cans, and .05 L or 330 ml bottles.

Grimbergen – Ambrée or Blonde in 330 ml.

Malty Beer – in 330 ml.

Shikma – Amber Ale, IPA Beer, or Marzen Lager all in 330ml.

Tuborg – Green Beer or Strong Beer both in .5L or 330 ml.

Tempo Beverages: Red Stripe Beer – in 330 ml.

Beer Made in Mexico Imported to Israel: All must have an OK hechsher.

R.L. de C.V. - Grupo Modelo AB Inbev; Compañía Cervecera de Zacatecas, S. de R.L. de C.V.; and Cerveceria Modelo S. de R.L. de C.V.: Corona in regular, Extra, or Light; Coronita Extra; Modelo Ambar, Modelo Especial, or Especial Light; Montejo; Negra Modelo; Pacifico; and Victoria.

Beer Made in South Africa: All Beer is Yoshon in South Africa. Most of it under UOS hashgacha. They may or may not have a hechsher. Some are Dairy. For specific brands, do a search on the UOS website at: https://www.koshersa.co.za/

Beer Made in UK: All Beer made after 1st November 23 may be chodosh.
