CHODOSH UPDATE #2

We are pleased to update the kehillah of this year's latest Chodosh information regarding **flour, oats** and **barley**.

ALL BREAD, CAKES, and BISCUITS etc. **baked** by our licensees, are from crops which have been planted before Pesach and therefore do not present any problem of Chodosh.

These include:

*Stenhouse *Blooms *By Penina (Mrs Katz) *Cake Creations (Mrs Jacobson)
*Ludzkers Pizza *Melting Moments (Mrs Bolel) *Tasty Choices (Mrs Grunfeld)

- All pre-packed flour sold at Stenhouse, has no problem of *Chodosh*.
- Ordinary **non organic** plain and self-raising [cake] **English** flour, does not present a problem of *Chodosh*.

The following **non organic** flours do not present a problem of Chodosh:

- **Allinson** - Strong White Bread flour, White Baking flour, plain White and Wholemeal flour.
- **Asda** - Strong White Bread flour.
- **Lidl** - Belbake: Strong White Bread flour.
- **Marriage's** - Finest Plain flour, Finest Self Raising flour, Finest Strong White Bread flour, Strong Wholemeal flour, Very Strong 100% Canadian White flour and Very Strong 100% Canadian Wholemeal flour. [Only these types can be guaranteed not to contain any Chodosh flour.]
- **Tesco** - Strong White Flour.
- **Wessex Mills** – Strong White Bread Flour, Wholemeal Bread Flour, Mixed Grain Bread flour and Six Seed Bread flour.

Similarly, any flour which has on the bag a "**red tractor logo**", does not present a problem of Chodosh.

All other flour, especially **Canadian, Wholemeal** or **Organic**, could present a problem of Chodosh when marked with the production code **4336** and onwards [production date 01-Dec-24].

RYE AND SPELT FLOUR

Doves farm Rye and Spelt flour, **Marriage's** light Spelt flour, and Dark Rye flour, **Matthews - Cotswold** White Spelt flour and Wholemeal Spelt flour, **Shipton Mills** White Spelt Flour, **Wessex Mills** White and Wholemeal Spelt Bread flour do not present a problem of Chodosh this year.

ORGANIC FLOUR

Doves farm White Bread flour and Wholemeal Bread flour, **Shipton Mills** Cake and Pastry White flour, do not present a problem of Chodosh this year.

OATS

Scottish oats could present a problem from the code **4282** and onwards [production date 08-Oct-24] or with the Best Before end September '25 [Sainsbury's, Best Before 1st April '26] as written previously in the Chodosh update #1.

BARLEY

Malted Barley in manufactured products could present a problem from the code **4288** and onwards [production date 15-Oct-2024].

All UK barley this year is free from Chodosh.

Oats and Barley should **not** be stored in a warm place to avoid infestation.

ORLOH ALERT / UPDATE

Avocados and **Pomegranates** which come from Eretz Yisroel should not be bought, as they are now a concern of ORLOH.
